Application and entry requirements

We are interested in professional designers or people who have recently concluded a first cycle design programme (BA level) and want to broaden their knowledge. Applicants must have completed a Bachelor's Degree or university programme of 180 higher education credits, of which 90 higher education credits in a design related subject. University credits given in other artistic disciplines or comparable working experience can in some instances be deemed acceptable. Application is made through a written proposal outlining the aims and nature of the studies to be undertaken. The MA programme in Design requires self-disciplined studies and a good knowledge of English.

The degree

If all other conditions are fulfilled, the programme will be the basis of a Degree of Master of Arts (2 Years) in Design. Specific checks are made of the applicants' qualifications to ascertain whether a Masters Degree can be awarded.

You should present no more than eight boards, size A3. Digital material will not be accepted, with the exception of screen-based media such as web design, film, TV graphics, computer games and video.

Selection

An admission board will assess the applications, the design proposals, the project descriptions and the portfolios. Please note that just as much attention is paid to the design proposals and project descriptions as to the portfolio presentations when making assessments. Work experience from design or closely related areas is considered a merit. You could possibly be called to an interview or discussion. Notice of admission will be sent by post in the end of June.
